POWERNET General Classification

Riding time, less any bonuses, is taken for each stage. The rider with the lowest aggregate time will be first on general classification; the rider with the next lowest aggregate time will be second, and so on.

Times will be taken in seconds only, so that a group of riders in a close bunch will be credited with the same time. Time bonuses, credited for the first three placings of each stage (except Stage 1); and for the first three placings in Intermediate (●) sprints as listed; are subtracted from the actual riding time. Please note the differing points for full and half stages.

TIME BONUS (in seconds)

Stages 3, 6 and 7: 1st – 10, 2nd – 6, 3rd – 4;

Stages 2, 4, 5, 8 and 9: 1st – 6, 2nd – 4, 3rd – 2.

TIME BONUS—INTERMEDIATE SPRINTS (in seconds)

HARCOURTS REAL ESTATE Sprint Ace

1st – 3; 2nd – 2; 3rd – 1.



REGENT CAR COURT Under 23 Classification

All riders eligible for UCI Under 23 category in 2008 shall be included. Placings shall be determined by the general classification by time.



WENSLEYS AVANTI PLUS Team Classification

The team classification for the day shall be calculated on the basis of the sum of the three best individual times from each team. The team general classification shall be calculated on the basis of the sum of the three best individual times, excluding bonuses, from each team in each stage ridden.
