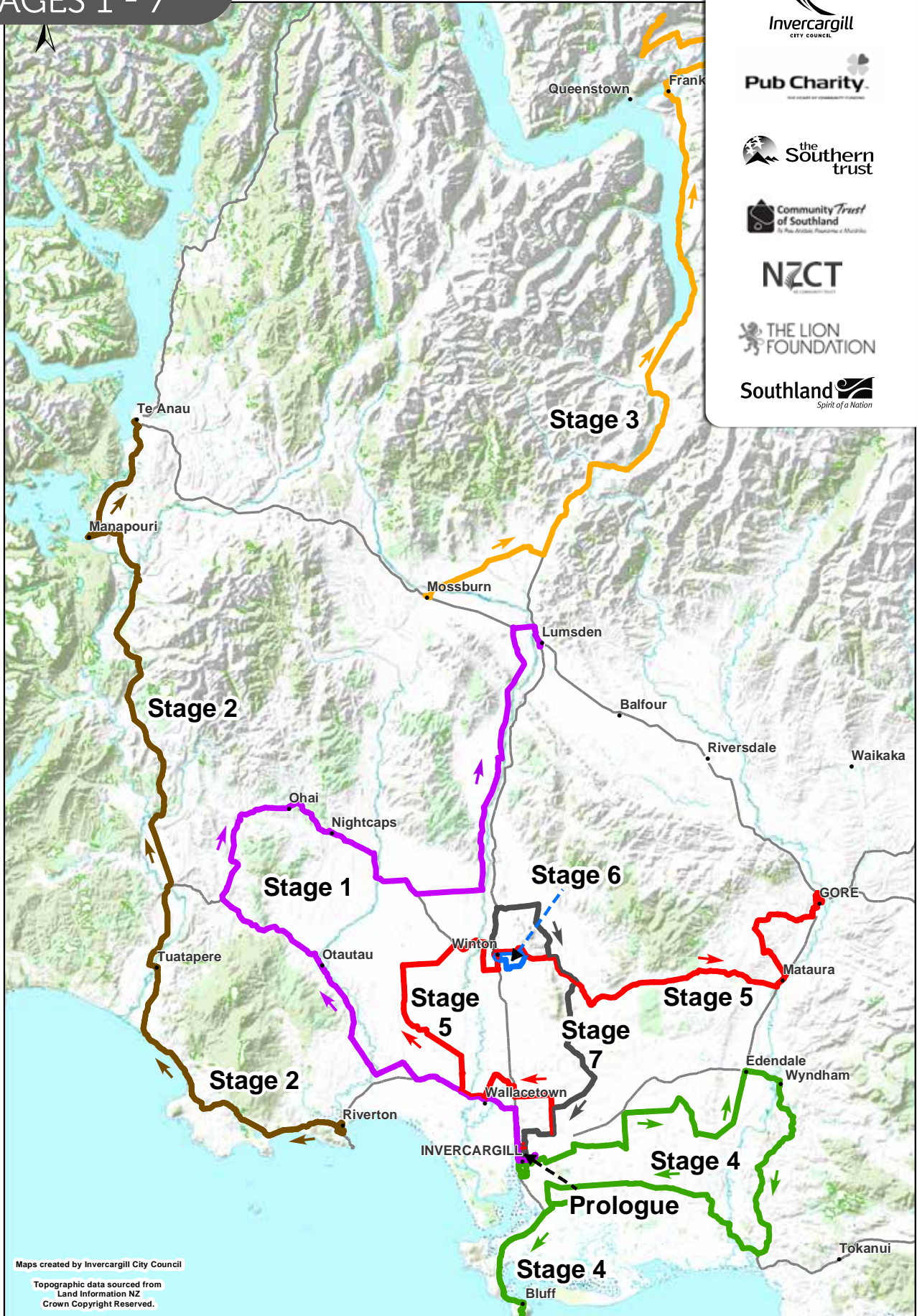

Riding time, less any bonuses, is taken for each stage.

The rider with the lowest aggregate time will be first on general classifications; the rider with the next lowest aggregate time will be second, and so on.

Times will be taken in seconds only, so that a group of riders in a close bunch will be credited with the same time. Time bonuses, credited for the first three placings in Intermediate (●) sprints as listed; are subtracted from the actual riding time.
